



### M.Sc. Study Regulation § 4 (3) – Replacement of a compulsory course of the module „Economic Theory and Policy“

In general students are expected to take part in all 5 lectures listed under the module "Economic Theory and Policy". §4 (3) gives students the possibility to replace one compulsory lecture with an 6 ECTS elective.

#### Important remarks:

- Failed exams can be repeated three times (§8 (1)). Failed attempts regarding the concerned compulsory lecture and the respective elective replacing the latter are accumulated.
- To exchange a mandatory course that has successfully been passed for an elective with a better grade is not possible! (§8 (4))

  - Then the 20 weeks start counting!




