Once you want to attend a course, you need to go to HISinONE


As a first-year student we recommend you to take the four mandatory courses and you might want to consider Advanced Mathematics for Economics and Finance.

4) Make your own schedule

Please note that since the courses will be pre-recorded, you do not need to follow this schedule. This is only an orientation of when you can expect the video lectures to be uploaded.

5) Follow the lectures - Ilias

With the registration to the course in HISinONE, you should automatically be granted access to the same course in Ilias, the teaching platform of the University of Freiburg.

In Ilias you will find all the materials of the course: the video recordings of the lectures and tutorials, the slides, problem sets, etc...

In the first session of the course, you will be informed about the format of teaching, whether there are live chats, live sessions, how to access them, etc...

In case you are not automatically registered in Ilias after registering for the course, you should be given a password by the instructor of the course that you can use to log in to that course in Ilias.

If you cannot access some lectures but you can access some others, please contact the Chair offering that course. You can find information about the Chair offering the course in the excel sheet or in HISinONE.
