Admission to a higher semester

Information for students who have successfully completed at least one semester of coursework in a degree equivalent to the M.Sc. Economics in English language and wish to continue their studies at the M.Sc. Economics at the University of Freiburg

Admission criteria

In order to be admitted at a higher semester, applicants must fulfill both the criteria for being admitted to the first semester and the additional criteria for being admitted at a higher semester:

- 1) Admission criteria for **admission to the first semester**:
 - a. Grade point average (GPA) in previous studies of at least 2,5 according to the German grading system. Here you can learn how to convert your grade. LINK
 - b. Applicants should have acquired at least 24 ECTS in Microeconomics, Macroeconomics, Mathematical Methods and Quantitative Methods (Probability, Statistics, Econometrics) at the Bachelor level.
 - c. Sound knowledge of English at the level C1 of the CEFR. Here you can find more information on the equivalence of different English certifications. LINK
 - d. For international applicants, the Bachelor degree must be recognized by the Central Office for Foreign Education at the ANABIN database.
 - e. Additional requirements and more information about the criteria for admission at the first semester can be found at our website https://master.econ.uni-freiburg.de/application
- 2) Additional admission criteria for admission to a higher semester:
 - a. Successful completion of at least one semester's worth of courses in a Master of Economics program or equivalent (30 ECTS or more). In order to be acknowledged, these courses must have been taught in English and must be master-level Economics courses.
 - **b.** For applicants currently enrolled at a degree in Economics in Germany, certificate of possession of the right of examination signed by the Examination Office (*Unbedenklichkeitbescheinigung*).
