Replacement of a Compulsory Course of the Module "Economic Theory and Policy" (Replacement Joker)

In general, students are expected to take part in all five lectures listed under the module "Economic Theory and Policy." These lectures are Advanced Macroeconomics I, Advanced Microeconomics I, Advanced Macroeconomics II, Advanced Microeconomics II and Economic Policy and Public Choice.

The examination rules under §4 (3) give the students the possibility to replace one of the compulsory lectures from the Economic Theory and Policy module with a 6 ECTS internal elective.

Courses from the quantitative methods module (Intermediate Econometrics and Computational Economics) and those from the profile (Constitutional Economics for E&P, Principles of Finance for F and Electronics Markets / Network Economics for ISNE) cannot be replaced.
